Walk the road where faith, courage, and liberty helped shape a nation.

From the colonial streets of Boston to the monuments of Washington, D.C., The Road to a Nation is an inspiring journey through some of the most important places in America's story. Pastors Winston Parrish and Heath Williams will be your hosts as you trace the influence of America's spiritual heritage through sites connected with George Whitefield, Jonathan Edwards, D. L. Moody, and other influential figures. Stand where patriots debated independence, soldiers endured the winter at Valley Forge, and a new nation established the principles of representative government. Along the way, experience historic churches, battlefields, landmarks, museums, and national memorials that bring the American story to life.

This is more than a sightseeing tour. It is an opportunity to consider the faith, sacrifice, courage, and conviction woven throughout America's history—and to remember the generations who traveled the road before us.

DAY 1 — BOSTON: WHERE THE STORY COMES ALIVE: Welcome to Boston!

Arrive in Boston and begin our journey in one of America's most historic cities. After time for lunch on your own at lively Quincy Market, we'll enjoy a guided tour introducing us to the people, places, and events that made Boston a cradle of American independence. We'll also visit the Longfellow House, a historic property with connections to both the American Revolution and one of America's most celebrated poets. Tonight, enjoy fellowship and an included dinner at Maggiano's before settling into our Boston-area hotel.

DAY 2 — FAITH THAT SHAPED A PEOPLE

After breakfast, our exploration of America's spiritual heritage begins at Phillips Academy, where we'll visit Missionary Rock and consider the missionary movement that sent generations of Americans around the world. We continue to Old South Presbyterian Church in Newburyport, the final resting place of renowned Great Awakening evangelist George Whitefield. After an included lunch at Michael's Harborside, we travel to Providence, Rhode Island, to visit First Baptist Church, whose history is closely associated with Roger Williams and the principle of religious liberty. Our day concludes with an included dinner at the historic Publick House in Sturbridge, Massachusetts.

Overnight: Ludlow, Massachusetts

DAY 3 — REVIVAL, CONVICTION & COURAGE

Today we explore the lives and legacies of remarkable Americans. Visit the Moody Homestead and Moody Center and discover the story of evangelist D. L. Moody, whose ministry influenced millions in America and around the world. We'll also stop at a marker commemorating Jonathan Edwards and his preaching, recalling the powerful spiritual awakening that swept through the colonies during the 18th century. After lunch on your own, continue to the Nathan Hale Homestead, associated with the young American patriot remembered for his extraordinary devotion to the cause of liberty. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Overnight: New Brunswick, New Jersey Area

DAY 4 — THE BIRTH OF AMERICAN LIBERTY

After breakfast, travel to Valley Forge National Historical Park, where the Continental Army endured the legendary winter of 1777–78. Here, stories of perseverance, leadership, sacrifice, and determination offer a moving perspective on the price of independence. Then it's on to Philadelphia, where we'll walk through the historic heart of the city and visit Independence Hall, where both the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution were debated and adopted. Following lunch on your own, experience the outstanding Museum of the American Revolution, where artifacts and immersive exhibits tell the dramatic story of America's struggle for independence. Enjoy an included dinner in Philadelphia before traveling south to the Washington, D.C., area for a two-night stay.

DAY 5 — REMEMBERING THE COST OF FREEDOM

Our final full day brings us face-to-face with the institutions, memorials, and sacrifices that continue to define the American experience. At Arlington National Cemetery, a tram tour takes us through one of the nation's most sacred places as we remember those who served and sacrificed. We'll continue to the U.S. Capitol Visitor Center before experiencing Washington's extraordinary memorials. Our memorial walk includes the World War II Memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, and Vietnam Veterans Memorial. Along the way, we'll see the Washington Monument, stop for a photograph near the White House, and drive by the Library of Congress and U.S. Supreme Court. Following an included dinner at the Fish Market Restaurant, our journey reaches a meaningful conclusion with an evening prayer service at Top of the Town, overlooking the nation's capital. It is a fitting place to reflect on the people, principles, sacrifices, and faith we have encountered along *The Road to a Nation*.

DAY 6 — HOMEWARD BOUND

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our flight home, carrying with us a deeper appreciation for the remarkable people and defining moments that helped shape the United States of America.

General Conditions

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1000.00 per person is due January 20, 2027. The final payment is due February 25, 2027. Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for an additional non-refundable fee of 3%. Reservations received after March 1, 2027 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per person up until 91 days before departure. For cancellations from 90 - 31 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 50% of the tour price. There will be no refund for cancellations within 30 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to TEMPLETON TOURS INC. in writing.

FARE INCLUSIVE: Roundtrip air transportation from Charlotte, NC (CLT). Five (5) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in quality hotel accommodations. 10 Meals consisting of 5 breakfasts (B) 1 Lunch (L), and 4 table d'hote dinners (D). Sightseeing by private motorcoaches, utilizing the services of a local licensed speaking guide. Entrance fees for select attractions. Group transfers between airports and hotels. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. Tips to guides, motorcoach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e., maitre d', table waiter, etc.) are also included. The brochure price is per person in US dollars based on double occupancy.

TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE: TTI strives to adhere to the printed itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate changes without advance notice during the tour. TTI reserves the right to change the itinerary, and is not responsible for any changes caused by unforeseen circumstances beyond our control.

TOUR CANCELLATION: TTI reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the tour at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by TTI, the sole and exclusive responsibility of TEMPLETON TOURS is to refund all monies recovered.

NOT INCLUDED: Lunches and food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with the table d'hote meals; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, room service orders, etc.; transportation between the home city and the departure city.

AIR ROUTINGS: The price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45 day Apex fare. TTI reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 90 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit of \$295 will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Passengers planning to arrange their own air transportation must notify TTI in writing on or before January 20, 2027. Seat numbers will be assigned by the airline at check-in; specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Passengers are responsible for providing frequent flyer information upon check-in.

HOTELS: Tour prices are per person, based on two people sharing a room. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$695. (Tour participants without a roommate will be charged a single supplement surcharge.)

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One (1) piece of checked luggage whose overall dimensions do not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. One (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Tips to hotel porters are included for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. Regulations are subject to change without notice. Please read the monthly correspondence from TEMPLETON TOURS for the most current information. Dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances are prohibited in your luggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

DISABILITIES: Due to the amount of walking at the sites we will visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour. TEMPLETON TOURS, INC. reserves the right to refuse passage to anyone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond which we can provide. The tour requires a substantial amount of walking and many of the sites are not accessible by wheelchair.

INSURANCE: Acting only as agents for suppliers, TEMPLETON TOURS is not responsible for flight delays or missed connections, damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident, illness and/or death as a result of any occurrences or conditions beyond its control, including, but not limited to, defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, strikes, terrorist attacks, hostage situations, kidnappings, hijackings, protests, riots, public demonstrations, inclement weather, or theft. For your protection, we highly recommend that you purchase travel insurance to cover these possibilities. Information will be provided with your tour confirmation.

PRICE CHANGES: Tour conditions and air fares are subject to Governmental, IATA, ARC, and airline regulation requirements in effect at the date of and during the tour. All rates are quoted in US dollars and are subject to change without notice. Taxes and fuel surcharges are included in your tour cost and are subject to change without notice.
